IMPORTANT DETAILS

Language

The Trade Fair is French speaking. Therefore, one member of our staff will supervise international teams in English. We will request the help of some Belgian teams registered to EwB to accompany you such as sponsors.

The stand/stall*

Provided: Table (180 x 80 cm), black cover, balloons, individual tag, panel mentioning the name of your company + country. You may bring your own material but we ask you to send us the plan of your stand in case you bring your own panels (by e-mail or fax).

*It is not allowed to sit down.

Accommodation

Students and adults sleep in the same Youth Hostel. Girls and boys will be separated. In some cases, we may ask the adults from a same group and gender to share the room. **If you want a single room**, we reserve a double room that you will have to pay and use as a single room. Please, let us know about your preferences.

4. The best team

Visual impact of your stand, clear name and information of team and product, product quality, effective commercial approach, team spirit, well-built business plan, effective cooperation between people, effective learning of entrepreneurial activities.

5. The best poster advertising

Your team gets 10 minutes to realize an advert that promotes your company/product or service on a poster.

We provide: markers, magazines, black pencils, eraser, ruler, cut material, sheets of coloured paper...

- 1. We ask you to send us your presentation on the internet link before January 5, 2015
- 2. The recording of this presentation must last maximum **3 minutes** and must be the same as the one you will present on Sunday
- 3. The teams participating to the "3 minutes to convince" competition are selected by a pre-jury
- 4. The results will be announced by the end of January (e-mail)
- 5. If your team is selected, you will have to repeat your show on Saturday afternoon (mandatory) at the same time as the Trade Fair; this is why we ask at least 1 member of your team **to stay at your stand**
- 6. Your music/video must be engraved on CD or on USB in 1 file
- 7. We provide a professional infrastructure for the repetitions and the show
- 8. Your "3 minutes show" cannot be a film, but your show may be based on a film/video projection.
